1. Care Models and Therapeutic Strategies Covers topics from individual management to the coordination of multidisciplinary care networks, with special attention to children and severe cases.

2. Immune and Neurovascular Mechanisms Presents cutting-edge research on autoimmunity, microcoagulation, neuroinflammation, and emerging phenotypes that are redefining the understanding of the disease.

3. Exercise Physiology and Muscle Dysfunction Explores the peripheral mechanisms of exercise intolerance, with emphasis on alterations in muscle metabolism, mitochondrial dysfunction, and cardiopulmonary testing.

4. Multisystemic Cardiopulmonary Dysfunction Focuses on the interactions between the respiratory, cardiovascular, and neurovascular systems in complex post-viral conditions.

The event will also feature opening and closing sessions led by internationally renowned researchers and clinicians, including the director of the Open Medicine Foundation.
